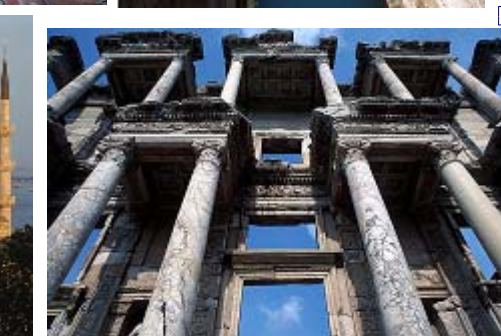

TURKEY, GREECE AND ITALY

DAY 1: DEPART CHICAGO Boarding our overnight flight, we are off on the adventure of a lifetime to Istanbul, Turkey.

DAY 2: ISTANBUL, TURKEY Upon arrival in Istanbul, Turkey's largest city, your guide will meet you and transfer to your hotel in town. In the afternoon discover the city and visit Church of Chora and Spice Market. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 3: ISTANBUL/ IZMIR Full day tour of Istanbul. In the morning drive to the old town and visit Hipodrome and the famous Blue Mosque, visit Topkapi Palace Museum, see the Sultan's Treasury and Porcelain collections. In the afternoon visit St. Sophia Church and The Grand Bazaar. Transfer to the airport in time to connect with your flight at the end of the day to Izmir (ancient Smyrna). Upon arrival transfer to your hotel. Dinner and Overnight in Izmir.

DAY 4: IZMIR / SARDES / PHILADELPHIA / LAODICEA / COLOSEA / PAMUKKALE In the morning drive thru Izmir, site of Polycarp's death and the church. Start for a day of exploration of the Seven Churches. Drive eastward to Sardes visit the Temple of Artemis (Diana), the Byzantine church, restored Synagogue and Gymnasium. Continue your drive to Alasehir (Philadelphia) visit the remains of the church. In the afternoon continue to Colossea, where one of the Seven Churches existed. Then visit Laodicea from 3rd Cenury. View the church and the theater. Dinner and overnight in Pamukkale.

DAY 5: PAMUKKALE / HIERAPOLIS / - EPHEBUS / KUSADASI In the morning visit ancient Hierapolis, the ancient thermal center. See the ruins and the calcium deposits, natural lake-warm pools. Continue to Ephesus. First visit the Church of St. John, it is the best preserved and the leading of the Seven Churches where St. John was buried. Walk thru the ancient city of Ephesus once a port town gateway. See the spectacular ruins and the Grand Theater where St. Paul preached. Visit the House of Mary where she spent her last days. Allow time for shopping. Transfer to your hotel for Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

DAY 6: KUSADASI / THYATIRA / PERGAMUM / CANAKKALE Depart in the morning north and visit Thyatira (Kaiser), which was famous for purple dyes, and Jezebel. View the ancient Temple. Continue to Pergamum, here was another one of the Seven churches. Visit Acropol, see the Altar of Zeus, Citadel, Trajan temple, amphitheater. Later Aesculapium which was the earliest healing Center. In the afternoon continue north, pass by in a distance Assos where Paul met Barnabas and walked to Alexander Troas where they sailed to Philippi. Dinner and overnight in Canakkale.

DAY 7: CANAKKALE / KAVALA, GREECE Cross Dardanel's strait from Asia to Europe, drive thru the Gallipoli War 1915 battlefields over Gelibolu and Kesan. Reach to Greek Border at noon and cross to Greece. Continue into the modern port city of Kavala, ancient Neapolis, where Paul accompanied by Silas, Luke and Timothy, first set foot in Europe. Aside from the great panoramas of Kavala, the city has a Byzantine castle, aqueduct, and visit the museum containing finds from ancient Amphipolis and Philippi. Dinner and overnight in Kavala.

DAY 8: KAVALA/ PHILIPPI/ THESSALONIKI Tour Philippi, where Paul delivered his first sermon in Europe, sowing the seeds of Christianity. Here Paul baptized "a certain woman named Lydia" the first Christian convert in Europe. The Roman Forum, completely excavated, is from after Paul's time. Among the ruins, located on the rocky ledge above the town's main road, is the "prison" where Paul and Silas were thrown. In the rocks you will find inscriptions and carved reliefs of deities. It was in Philippi that Octavian and Antony defeated Brutus and Cassius, last defenders of the Roman Republic in 42 BC. Continue to Thessaloniki, the

former capital of Macedonia. Paul preached there during the winters of 49-50 AD and wrote the two epistles to the ancient Thessalonians. See the ramparts of the city, the Triumphal Arch of Galerius straddling the Via Egnatia, once a strategic artery of the Roman Empire. Dinner and overnight in Thessaloniki.

DAY 9: THESSALONIKI/ VERIA/ METEORA Enjoy this morning a city tour of Thessaloniki where Paul preached during the winter of 49-50 AD and wrote two epistles to the ancient Thessalonians. See the ramparts of the city, the triumphal Arch of Galerius staddling the Via Egnatia, once a strategic artery of the Roman Empire. Depart for Meteora Monasteries stopping on the way at Veria. In ancient times this town was known as Berea or Beroea. Paul and Silas preached here and there is a monument dedicated to Paul. Dinner and overnight in Kalambaka.

DAY 10: KALAMBAKA/ DELPHI/ ATHENS This morning drive to visit Delphi the most important sanctuary, was the absolute guiding power to the Greeks. Visit The Temple of Apollo, the Treasury of the Athenians the Theatre of the sanctuary and much more. Drive to Athens with a stop at Levadia. Drive to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

DAY 11: ATHENS Morning city sightseeing of Athens which will include a visit to the world renowned Acropolis, with the ruins of the Parthenon, Erectheum and Propylea. Thereafter we will ascend Mars Hill, where Paul preached. Also, visit the Agora (ancient market place, and former center of Athenian public life), the House of Parliament, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Palace, now called the Presidential Palace. Return to your hotel for the balance of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Athens..

DAY 12: ATHENS/ CORINTH/ ROME Depart this morning for a sightseeing tour of ancient Corinth, seeing the Archaeological Museum, the Bema, and the Market Place and Temples. Corinth was home to St. Paul for 18 months. From the Bema at Corinth, Paul spoke to the Corinthians about Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. On the way to Corinth, we will stop for a few minutes at the Corinth Canal, which separates Peloponnese from the Greek Mainland and connects the two Seas (Ionian and Aegean). Return to Athens International airport for your flight to Rome. AZ 721 @ 7:25PM arriving Rome @ 8:40PM. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (Dinner will be served on the flight) Overnight in Rome.

DAY 13: ROME, THE ETERNAL CITY This morning enjoy a city tour of Rome. Visit the Vatican Museums with the Sistine Chapel and Michaelangelo's frescoes, St. Peter's Basilica. Visit the Colosseum, the Forum and the Mamertine Prison. Return to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 14: ROME After breakfast, in the morning tour some of the city's past splendor and pass by legendary monuments, palaces, ruins, squares and fountains. You will also visit the Catacombs of Santa Domitilla where the early Christians held their forbidden services and buried their dead. Drive to visit The Basilica of St Paul Outside the Walls which was founded by the Roman Emperor Constantine I over what was believed to be the burial place of Saint Paul, where it was said that, after the Apostle's execution, his followers erected a memorial, called a cella memoriae, over his grave. This first edifice was expanded under Valentinian I. Continue to visit the Church of St. Paul of the Three Fountains, located just outside Rome. It is said to be built on the spot where St. Paul was beheaded by order of Nero. There are two other churches also located on the grounds. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 15: ROME/ CHICAGO Transfer to Rome International Airport for your return flight to Chicago, arriving in the afternoon local time.
